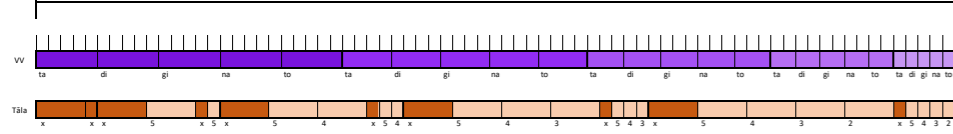
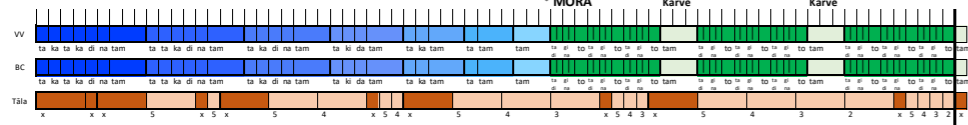
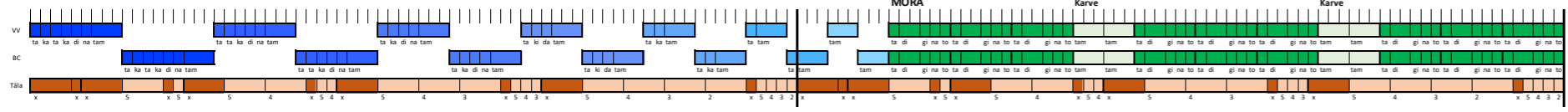
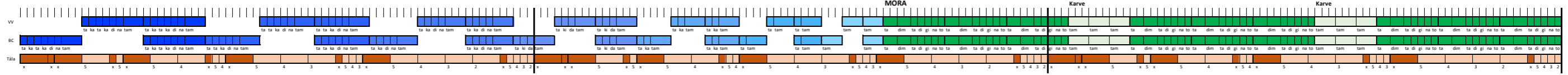
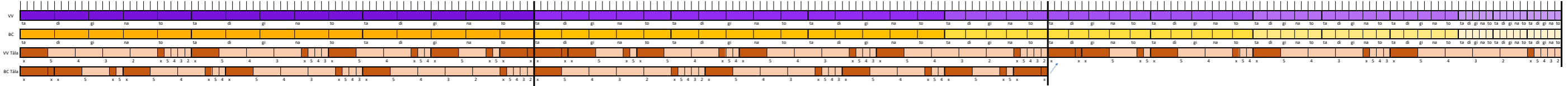
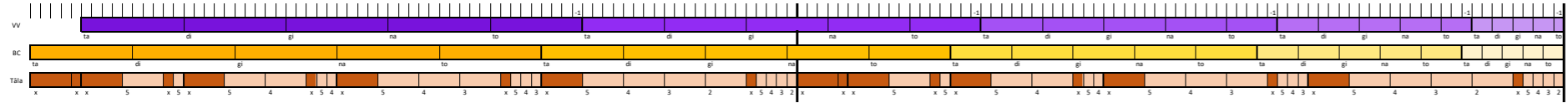


CYCLE 1 - 13.875s
